= Chain Cotillion — La Novellé Holénoise — La nouvelle Hollandaise — New Holland.

The cotillion was a popular ballroom dance in Europe and North America in the 18th century. Its popularity lasted for around fifty years, until it was replaced by the quadrille in the 19th century.
